**Working Equitation Clinic with optional schooling tests at the end of your clinic. Learn how to ride obstacles, learn how to set them up, and the rules of Working Equitation. Find the rules at <https://usawe.org/competitions/rules/> You may also ride schooling rides without attending the clinic.**

#### **Clinic Format:**

We will set up the obstacle course as a group to learn about their layout and the rules. Then we will work in groups of a maximum of 6 riders and ride all the obstacles on the course. At the end of your clinic, you will have the option to ride through the whole course and be judged on your performance if you want feedback. You may also ride without getting feedback.

#### **Fees:**

<b>Optional schooling - ride the course at the end of your clinic – per ride</b>	<b>\$25</b>
<b>Schooling ride without attending the clinic- per ride</b>	<b>\$35</b>
<b>Trailer-in fee</b>	<b>Free for all participants of the clinic</b>
<b>Day stall (per day) proof of vaccination required</b>	<b>\$50</b>
<b>Shavings (per bag) – one bag required</b>	<b>\$12 no outside shavings are allowed</b>

**There has been an increase of EHV-1 in the United States – we therefore require proof of vaccination (flu/rhino) within 6 months of participation. We recommend that your horse has been vaccinated at least 14 days before the show to achieve immunity. You can show proof via a vet bill or the receipt of vaccine purchase if you administer it yourself.**

**Entries:** Use the entry form on the Classical Horse Club website (available at <https://www.classicalhorse.org>)

Online entries are available using PayPal – you do not need to create a PayPal account to use this option. For paper entries – fill out the online form and then hit the print button at the bottom. Make checks payable to Classical Horse Club and send entries together with check to secretary. Ride times will be sent via e-mail and will be posted on the website.

### **Stabling**

10x10 temporary stalls with doors and metal roofing. Stabling will be available \$50 per day per stall. Stabling is limited and must be reserved by emailing tara@ofhorseyoucan.com. Stalls will be available on a first come, first served basis, stripping at the end of the show is included. Bedding is on sale for \$12/ bag. **No outside bedding is allowed.** Stall floors are dirt, and at least one bag of bedding is required per stall. Hay can also be purchased for \$20 per bale. We offer grass and a grass/alfalfa mix.

**Directions:** The Of HORSE You Can arena is located at the Denver Polo Club Fields. The address is 6359 Airport Road, Sedalia CO 80135. From Hwy 85 turn onto Airport Road at the traffic light and head west for about 0.5 miles. Turn right onto Airport Road (south) and follow road until you see the competition fields on your left. Parking is south of the competition arena and warm-up.

**Parking:** Day parking is close to the arena with access to water. There is very little shade, please plan ahead.

**An ASTM safety helmet is required at all times while mounted (exception for Western Dressage and WE competitors over the age of 18). No dogs are allowed on the show grounds.**
