**Working Equitation Three Phase or Triple challenge – How to enter:**

1. Enter a dressage test on Saturday – either USEF/ WDAA/USA WE
2. Enter the corresponding Ease of Handling and Speed Phase on Sunday
3. Enter the Triple Challenge or Three Phase class that matches your classes from above

**Example:** You wish to ride the Novice A obstacle classes on Saturday (classes 102 and 108). You could combine this with either a regular dressage test (Training 3 = class 6) or Western dressage ( Basic 4 = class 37) or USAWE (Novice A = class 51). To count all three classes for an overall score you enter dressage on Saturday, Ease of Handling and Speed classes on Sunday and the corresponding overall class on Sunday – either 121, 116 or 111. Email or call show secretary if you have questions.

***Check classes 111 – 125 to figure out your exact combination – see below.***

***Please note: There is no speed phase for Intro Level.***

**There has been an increase of EHV-1 in the United States – we therefore require proof of vaccination (flu/rhino) within 6 months of participation. We recommend that your horse has been vaccinated at least 14 days before the show to achieve immunity. You can show proof via a vet bill or the receipt of vaccine purchase if you administer it yourself.**

**Stall strip fee: \$50 (you must provide a separate check for this – upon confirmation that you have stripped your stall we will return your check to you).**

***Please note – no shavings are available – you must bring your own.***

**Entries:** Use the entry form on the Classical Horse Club website (available at <https://www.classicalhorse.org/shows-and-clinics.html>)

Online entries are available using PayPal – you do not need to create a PayPal account to use this option. For paper entries – fill out the online form and then hit the print button at the bottom. Make checks payable to Classical Horse Club and send entries together with check to secretary. Ride times will be sent via e-mail and will be posted on the website.

**Refunds:** Up to May 21, 2021, all fees refunded except office fee. From day after closing to the day prior to competition, class fees will be refunded only if ride(s) can be filled from wait list. During the competition no refunds including Acts of God. ***Office fee is non-refundable.***

**Awards:** Ribbons to 5<sup>th</sup> place all divisions. First place prizes. Management reserves the right to break ties.

**Directions:** Take I-70 to the Eagle Exit #147. Turn out of the traffic circle onto Eby Creek Road. Turn out of the traffic circle onto Fairgrounds Road and follow the road for about 0.5 miles. The fairgrounds will be on your left.

**An ASTM safety helmet is required to be worn at all times while mounted (exception for Western Dressage and WE competitors over the age of 18). No dogs allowed.**
