




## 2022 DRESSAGE SEAT EQUITATION – INTRODUCTORY LEVEL TEST A

WESTERN DRESSAGE ASSOCIATION® OF AMERICA

Test may be ridden in an area of approximately 20 x 40 meters.

All jog work must be ridden sitting.



Gate/Exit

1. Working jog - long rail on the right side. Half circle left 20m in the last quarter of the arena.
2. Working walk - 5 steps across the diagonal, change rein, develop free walk to the rail.
3. Working walk - track right on the rail to the middle of the short side.
4. Working jog - clockwise on the rail. Half circle right 20m in the last quarter of the arena, proceed on the rail.
5. Halt - through the working walk before the corner. Free walk to exit.



All jog work must be ridden sitting.



Gate/Exit

1. Working walk - from gate diagonally to the right rail, track left. Halt.
2. Working jog - through the walk on the rail to the middle of the short side opposite the gate.
3. Working jog - circle left 20m
4. Working walk - proceed counterclockwise on the rail to a few steps past the corner. Working jog halfway to the corner
5. Halt 3 seconds. Free walk across diagonal to exit




## 2022 DRESSAGE SEAT EQUITATION – BASIC LEVEL TEST A

Test may be ridden in an area of approximately 20 x 40 meters.

All jog work must be ridden sitting.



Gate/Exit

1. Working walk - Start near the gate in a counter-clockwise direction to halfway to the rail.
2. Working jog - Track left on the rail and continue to the center of the long side of the arena, turn left 90 degrees to the center of the arena.
3. Working lope, right lead – circle 20m at center of the arena
4. Working jog - at center of arena. Proceed straight ahead. Turn left at the rail and continue halfway to the corner of the arena.
5. Working walk - turn on the diagonal. Working walk halfway to middle of the short side. Free walk to exit.



Test may be ridden in an area of approximately 20 x 40 meters.

All jog work must be ridden sitting.



Gate/Exit

1. Working jog - Start near the gate in a counter-clockwise direction to halfway to the rail. One 10m loop off the rail. Track left.
2. Working lope - circle left 20m at the middle of the short side, opposite the gate. Proceed on the rail.
3. Working jog - before the corner. Turn left and proceed across the diagonal. Develop free walk.
4. Working walk - before the rail. Track right.
5. Halt 4 seconds. Free walk to exit.



Test may be ridden in an area of approximately 20 x 40 meters.

All jog work must be ridden sitting.



1. Working jog - Start near the gate in a counter-clockwise direction
2. Working lope - circle 20m left at middle of long side
3. Working jog - circle 10m left at middle of the short side opposite the gate.
4. Halt. Half turn on forehand right (haunches left)
5. Working jog - clockwise on rail to middle of long side. Halt 4 seconds. Free walk on diagonal to exit.



Test may be ridden in an area of approximately 20 x 40 meters.

All jog work must be ridden sitting.



Gate/Exit

1. Working jog - from gate down centerline to the center of the arena. Circle right 10m.
2. Leg yield - left to rail. Continue working jog on rail, tracking right to middle of the short side, opposite gate.
3. Working lope right lead - circle right 20m
4. Halt - half turn on forehand left (haunches right)
5. Working jog - counterclockwise on rail to halfway down the long side. Halt 4 seconds. Free walk on diagonal to exit.




## 2022 DRESSAGE SEAT EQUITATION – LEVEL 2 TEST B

WESTERN DRESSAGE ASSOCIATION® OF AMERICA

Test may be ridden in an area of approximately 20 x 60 meters.

All jog work must be ridden sitting.



1. Collected jog - from gate in a counterclockwise direction. After corner, 10m circle left
2. Shoulder-in left to midpoint. Turn left across arena and track right.
3. Haunches-in right. Before the corner, straighten and working walk.
4. At the middle of the short side, opposite the gate, half circle right 20m working lope right lead. At the centerline, simple change of lead. Half circle left 20m. At the centerline, simple change of lead. Half circle right 20m
5. Collected jog at middle of the short side. Lengthen stride in jog across the diagonal to the middle of the long side. Collected jog. Half circle 10m to center line. Working walk half the length of the centerline. Proceed free walk to exit.
